- The One Toro Arts Booster Organization will handle the fair share funds that are paid into the band program. With the help of the booster organization, they will ensure that our funds are safe, protected, and allocated appropriately.

# Sticker Shock!!! I promise it will be ok!

- When you think about the cost of a travel sports team, or gymnastics, or dance, or competitive cheer, the cost is very high for the experiences provided. Our cost is extremely “low” given all of the experiences we will providing your young performer. Other programs in the area are close to double our fair share amount. Nationally, it is commonplace for band faire share fees to be in excess of \$2,000.00 a year. After our first year, the district will provide very little funding to our program. Therefore, fair share, fundraising, corporate sponsorships and donations are what we will depend on as our financial lifeline.
