Let's Talk Dual Enrollment!

Dual Enrollment is a program where elgibile high school students attend college classes and earn high school and college credits at the same time.

TCHS offers Dual Enrollment classes on campus and at St. Johns River State College (SJR) as well as First Coast Technical College (FCTC).

Students that are interested in participating in academic Dual Enrollment at TCHS or SJR need to have a 3.0 unweighted GPA and qualifying test scores (https://www-tchs.stjohns.k12.fl.us/guidance/dual-enrollment/).

The school counseling department will be hosting information sessions for students interested in participating in Dual Enrollment for the 22-23 school year in November. Students can sign up using the QR code in schoology, on the posters around school, or in the school counseling office.

Junior Meetings

The counselors have been meeting individually with each Junior. During the meetings, we review first quarter grades, graduation requirements/status, post-secondary planning, and next steps.

Juniors that are planning to attend a university immediately after graduation and/or are hoping to receive the Bright Futures scholarship should be taking their ACT and SAT <u>NOW</u>!

We are asking our juniors to start solidifying their postsecondary goals by having them take career interest inventories, review the educational requirements for their dream career, and narrowing down their postsecondary options as a result. Counselors are emailing documents with links and planning resources to each student and parent following the meeting.

SAT/ACT, PSAT?

Which test to take? When do I take it?

- All Sophomores are registered for the PSAT automatically. Freshman and Juniors may consider taking it for additional practice. Juniors are also encouraged to take the PSAT for National Merit Consideration. National Merit Homepage
- Juniors should take BOTH the SAT & ACT in the late Fall or Winter seasons. Once students know their "preferred" test, we encourage them to continue testing until they reach their desired score. The goal is to have a "college application ready" score by the beginning of senior year.
- Students interested in participating in **Dual** Enrollment may consider testing early. Students wanting to participate in DE as Juniors will need a qualifying test score in the early spring of Sophomore year.
