# Two ways to apply: Direct or Common Application

## Apply to UNF

We're excited you've chosen to apply to the University of North Florida! If you are ready to apply for admission, you're in the right place.  
Be sure to review the admission deadlines before you begin the application process.

### Begin Your Application:

Apply with UNF Application

Apply with Common App (freshmen only)

← Example

**Direct** refers to students that use the institutional application. These students will complete a separate application for each school that they apply to through the college/university's website.

**Common App** is a third-party resource that links with Naviance and the post secondary institutions allowing students to fill in information in one location for many schools.

**Note:** The Common Application does not open until August 1<sup>st</sup>. Students wishing to take advantage of summer application timelines (such as UNF's Apply in July) will need to apply directly through the university.

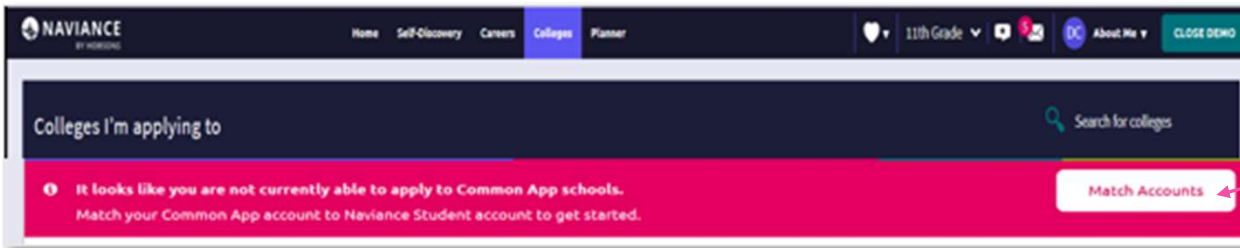

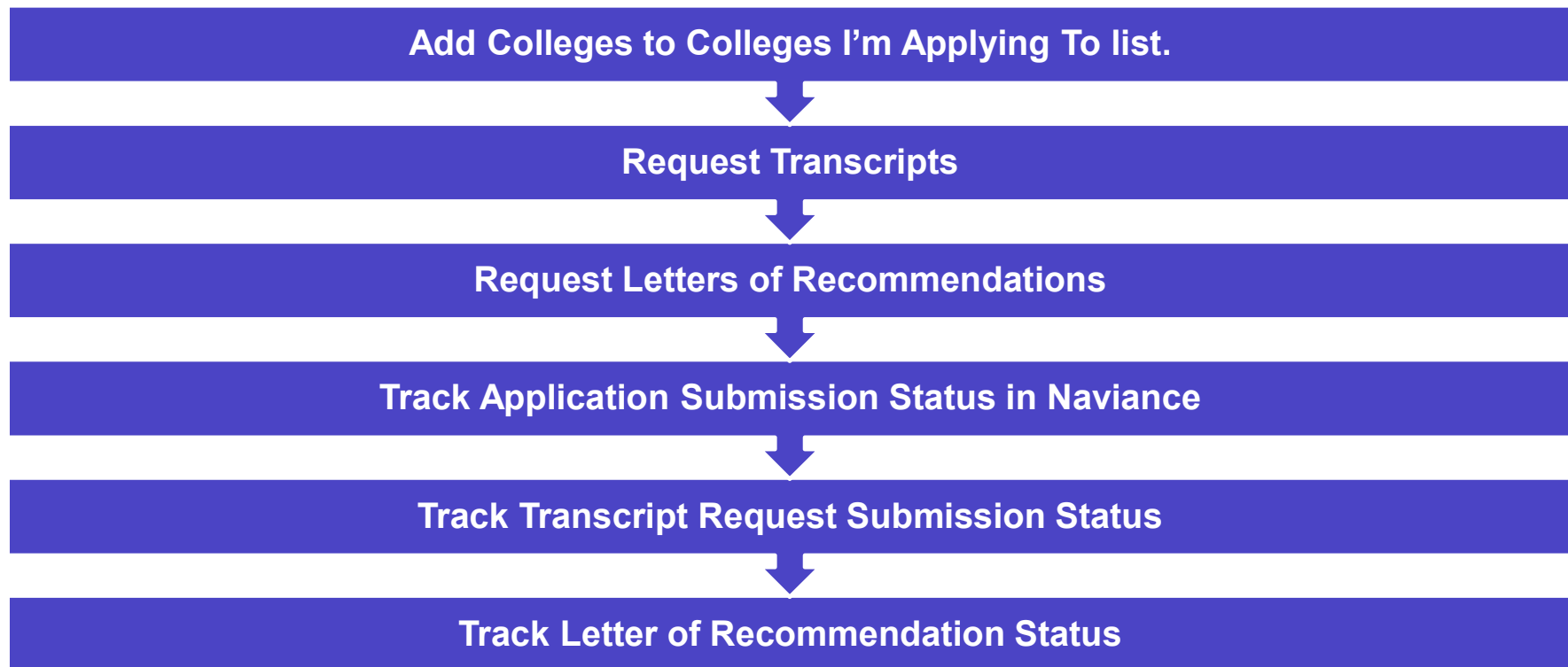

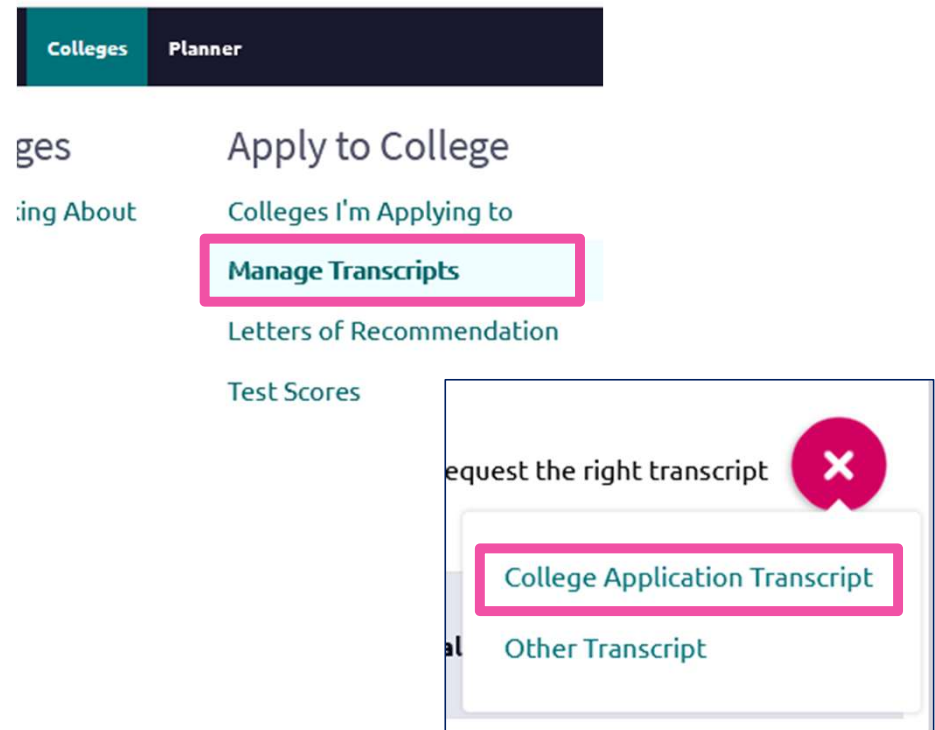

**Note:** You should only request transcripts if you have already applied to the school or are very certain you will apply in the future

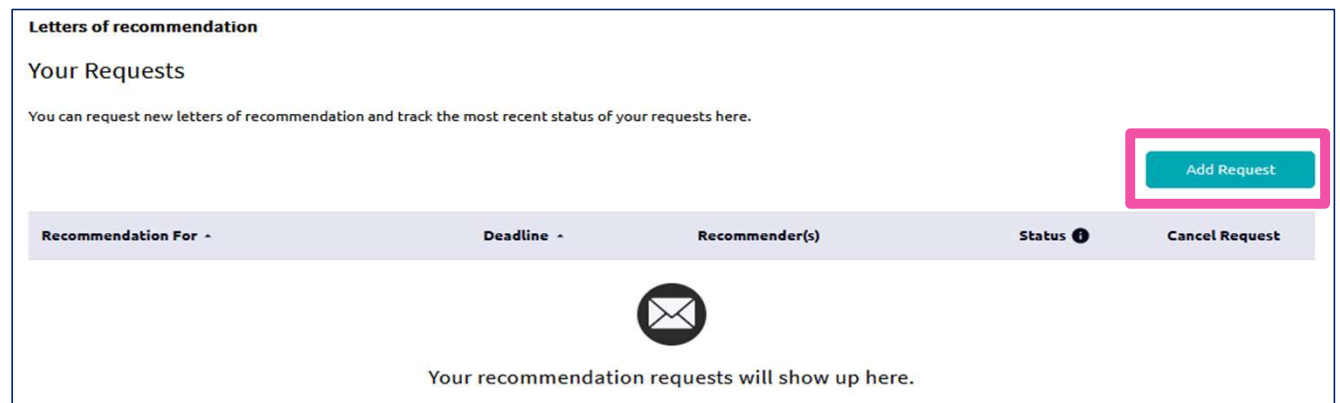
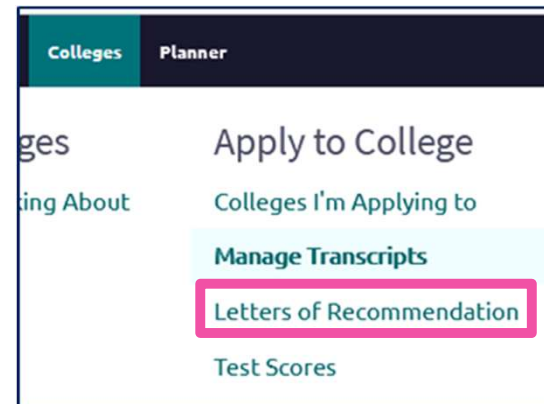

## Track Application Submission Status in Naviance

### Tracking College Transcripts & Application Materials Status

1. Go to **Colleges I'm Applying To List**
2. Check the **Transcript column** to review when a counselor has submitted a transcript
  - The transcript column will say '**sent**' if the transcript has been sent
3. Check the **Office Materials column** to review when a staff member has indicated that all materials have been sent for that application.
  - The Office Materials column will say '**submitted**' if transcripts and any other required materials, like Common App forms or other school-specific forms, have been sent

## Check your email, application portals, etc:

- It is your responsibility to keep up with any additional information requested by the college. Check your email, application portal, etc to confirm that you have submitted any fees, deposits, additional grades & test scores, etc that may be required.
- Note that the majority of our state universities require a **self report** of grades and test scores instead of an electronic transcript. It is your responsibility to use HAC or request a hard copy of your transcript to self report your grades to the college in their assigned format by their deadline.

- The Bright Futures Application and FAFSA will open **October 1<sup>st</sup>**.
- Check your institution, Schoology, and Naviance scholarships pages to see available scholarships throughout the year.
