- A focus on attendance: The number of student absent 15 or more days will decrease by $3 \%$ by the end of the 2022-2023 school year (moving from $23 \%$ to $20 \%$ ).
- A focus on Graduation: By the end of the school year, the pass rate for $11^{\text {th }} \& 12$ th grade FSA reading will increase by $5 \%$ ( $90 \%$ to $95 \%$ for seniors).
