	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Working on budget process for next school year. Expected to grow by 250 students next year. TCHS may not see some of the changes other schools will see. 650 students will be the average class size with 2,600 to 2,650 total students, getting 10 new portables and 2 bathroom portables. TCHS is NOT losing our nurse, SJCSO pays for nurse, but not required by the state. Biggest challenge for next year will be full classrooms with 45 students (mostly for electives) Rising 9th and 10th graders have completed scheduling for next year. Seniors are doing this now. Every student will meet with a guidance counselor. We receive funding for 5 guidance counselors but we have 6 and pay for the 6th guidance counselor out of TCHS funds We receive funding for 3 Deans but we have 4 and pay for the additional Dean out of TCHS funds Hiring 7-10 new teaching positions for next year, this does not include count for those who leave Parking is a big deal – Seniors will be getting a survey, not all seniors will get a parking spot. If student is not 16 on the first day of school, no parking spot for that year. No painting of the parking spots, but instead painting of the Toro heads. There will be a dedicated lot for those with a modified schedule. There will be a weighted spot for receiving a parking spot (see Bull Pen for full details) Prom is on a Thursday night but there is no school the next day. 1,000 tickets available. \$65 for seniors, higher price for juniors. Homecoming pays for prom and prom pays for senior expenses. Going into testing mode – gym will close and get computers for assessments, challenge is space not devices Next meeting – sharing school goals and then the following meeting will be about summer programs.
