	Principals Report –	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2,631 students at TCHS, we are the biggest school in St. Johns County. Target was 2,652 students, which is where we expect to be. The school was built for 2,100 students so we are 500 over capacity. Opened an additional 120 parking spots, students still need to meet the requirements. About 60 students left on the waiting list. Parking waitlist will end on Oct 11th. The only way to get a parking spot after Oct 11th is if a student with a parking spot leaves the school. Mr. Willets has asked the district to help cover the costs to create 3 more parking lots on the TCHS campus, the costs will be \$80-110K. Congestion – lunch settling in, working to add additional kiosks outside of the cafeteria for those not buying a full meal. 20 more tables and umbrellas were added outside the cafeteria. Next year there will probably be a need to have 4 lunch periods. Administration is watching the congestion in the stairwells and hallways. May need to make stairs be up only and down only. Some schools are locking down gates during the day and after hours, however, TCHS choose to handle it differently. Gates and doors will not be open unless there is a person securing that gate or door. All exclusion zones need approval or badge access, must be a registered volunteer, this is required by law. • State has the expectation that all students will wear a physical id on them at all times. TBD on when the state will implement this. However, Mr. Willets has already ordered physical ids for all students. • Next meeting we will discuss the TCHS Goal Plan. • TCHS is an A rated school again. 😊 • Club Rush is next week. • School goal is to share all the graduation details, which will include ticket count per student by winter break. • Prom has been moved to Deerwood Castle. • District will start discussing the ½ cent penny tax and the increase in milage rate to improve teacher and staff pay.
