It is District run. Need Algebra or higher, 3.0 end of 8<sup>th</sup> grade for high school classes, nothing lower than a C in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Pedro offers the Early College program as well, District runs a lottery for this academy.</li> <li>○ You can accomplish the same thing through dual enrollment, which is not an academy.</li> <li>○ Get your High School Diploma and AA Degree at end of high school.</li> <li>○ You do have more flexibility with dual enrollment as all classes are individually selected.
