- Academic Letter ceremony adjusting date so ignore date initially released. 4.0 weighted GPA, be here a year and a half (last school year and this semester), 450 students across the school. Look for a save the date in April. This applies to Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors.
- Testing season is upon us need proctors. All are digital and in the gym. 340 computer stations set up in the gym.

- TCHS is the District site for extended summer services for disability students. There will be lots of service hours offered at TCHS this summer.
- In hiring season 62 applications from internal transfers have been received
