








## ✅ Allowed & ❌ Prohibited Items for PSAT Testing









### Bring on Test Day

-  School ID (hard copy) **or** state-issued ID
  -  **Calculator** (approved models only, clear any saved formulas; cover under desk)
  -  Pen or pencil
  -  EL supports (translated directions or approved dictionary, if applicable)
  -  Backup calculator/batteries (under desk)

### During Breaks Only

-  Drink
  -  Snack
- 

### ❌ Prohibited During Test & Breaks (unless approved accommodations)

-  Phones, smartwatches, smart glasses, or other electronic devices
  -  Detachable privacy screens or  External keyboards (for laptops/Chromebooks)
  -  Notes, books, or reference materials
  -  **X** Scratch paper not provided by proctor
  -  Headphones, earbuds, or earplugs (unless required for assistive tech)
  -  Cameras, recording devices, or timers
  -  Brimmed hats may not be worn during testing; hoodie hoods must be down during testing

### Other Permitted Items (No Special Approval Needed)

-  Epinephrine auto-injector (e.g., EpiPen) in clear bag, under desk
  -  Eyeglasses
  -  Hearing aids
  -  Glucose pump (other supplies may require approval)
  -  Service animals (case-by-case; coordinator approval required)
