The ACT is a curriculum-based educational and career-planning tool that allows students to

- Be matched with colleges and **\$1+ billion in scholarships** through [ACT Recruit Me & Going Merry](#)
- **Send scores to colleges and universities**
- Meet **graduation testing requirements**
 - **Algebra 1 / Geometry EOC** → ACT Math **16+**
 - **FAST ELA Writing & Reading** → **18+ average** on ACT English & Reading

Any 11th-grade parent who does not wish their student to take the ACT on February 24, 2025, must sign this letter and have the student return it to the front office before Friday, February 20, 2026.
