

Good Afternoon Parents, Students and Guardians,

We are approaching the final stages of preparation, ordering and construction for our opening day on August 16, 2021 for the 2021 - 2022 school year. I have been a part of several meetings and site visits that have allowed our team to plan for a tremendous start for our Toros. As with any new school construction project, there will be some non-instructional areas that will still be undergoing final touches, however all classroom, cafeteria and student use areas will be prepared for our first day. To assist with the greatest area of questions our TCHS has been fielding, please review the informational bullets below:

- **Student Parking** Our inaugural parking pass application for rising Sophomores and Juniors is officially open! Please review the attached TCHS Parking Expectations document for important information regarding the application process and parking policies. - **Registration Update** Please be sure to complete the Returning Student Verification (RSV) sent via email from SJCSD. Reminders are sent weekly. Schedules and HAC will be placed on hold pending the completion of this process.
- Class Schedules Student schedules will be available in HAC beginning the week of August 9, 2021.
- Summer Reading Lists In an effort to respond to parent and student requests while continuing to promote literacy skill development, the <u>TCHS Summer Reading List</u> has been updated to include additional choice selections for all grade levels. To assist with new families moving into our area, <u>reading log assignments</u> will be due at the end of the first quarter and will be counted as a formative assignment for additional credit.
- **Supply Lists** TCHS will not post individual supply lists prior to school starting. Students will receive information from individual teachers as to necessary items for their class. It is recommended that students bring a general binder that can be divided into 7 different tabs to assist with organization of all classes. Each student will be provided one (1) TCHS Student Planner free of charge.
- **Lockers** All TCHS students will be issued a hallway locker located on the first two floors of building 4, PE and Band lockers will be issued as appropriate. Students will pay a one-time rental fee of \$5 per year (covers all assigned lockers).
- **Toro Swimming** A HUGE thank you for all the community support in helping TCHS find an aquatic home for our Toro Swimmers. We are in the final phases of completing the contractual process for a location just minutes from campus and look forward to announcing our "Home Pool" soon!
- **Student Clubs** Toros will have the opportunity to help TCHS develop various formal and informal clubs for all students to join.
