Rising 9th Grade Information

Rising 9th graders and students new to TCHS should change their FLVS accounts from their previous school to TCHS. This is imperative for the many students who are starting to take high school courses this summer so that when they complete the course, the high school will see the final grade and can make schedule adjustments if needed.

Steps for Changing Account:

- 1. Login into your FLVS account
- 2. Click the Virtual School Administrator link to enter VSA.
- 3. Click the menu (3 lines) at the top left of the screen next to FLVS.
- 4. Click Student Records then Academic Profile.
- 5. Click the dropdown to the right of the Physical School and select the new school.
- 6. Scroll to the bottom right and click SAVE.

Guidance News

<u>AP Students:</u> You can send **one score report for free** every year that you take AP Exams. The deadline for choosing the college, university, or scholarship program that you want to send your 2022 AP scores to for free is **June 20**. Here's how:

- Sign in to My AP using your College Board username and password.
- Go to My AP Profile and select the Score Send tab.
- Type in the name of your college or university. When it appears on the list, select it and hit Save.

Good to Know

- Are you a high school junior, sophomore, or freshman? Selecting a college to send your scores to with your 1 free score send can help you stand out to that college by showing them your interest early.
- Score reports include both this year's and past AP Exam scores.

If you miss the deadline to use your 2022 free score send or you want to send additional score reports, you can order score reports

online or by mail or fax anytime.

Junior Update:

School counselors will be visiting Juniors in their US History classes during the month of May! We will be completing a "super match" activity that will help students find their "best fit" schools to apply to for college. We will also be talking about how to start and finish the college application process. If you haven't already, now would be a great time to speak with your student about your family plans for location, type of school, areas of interest, etc. Once these visits are completed, the information will be shared via Schoology and the webpage.

SAT Update:

Registration for our last SAT of the spring, on June 4, is open for one more month. Juniors who haven't taken it yet should <u>register</u> today.

Students who've already taken the SAT should link their College Board accounts to Khan Academy® so they'll be well prepared to take it again in the summer or fall

<u>Bright Futures – New rules regarding Bright Futures Scholarship Service Forms/Rules</u> are posted on the District Web Site and will be available in the TCHS Guidance Services office.

Registration Update:

The counselors have finished meeting with all the students to select their courses. From this point forward, all schedule change requests should be requested through the link on our website: <u>https://www-tchs.stjohns.k12.fl.us/registration/courses/</u>. <u>The deadline</u> to request elective changes is June 2^{nd} .

SAT Update:

The SAT is designed to support the choices juniors will make about their life beyond high school. In fact, millions of students take the test each year as a step on their path to college. It's a globally recognized test that's the best way to show off the skills and knowledge colleges care about.
