Rising 9th Grade Information

Rising 9th graders and students new to TCHS should change their FLVS accounts from their previous school to TCHS. This is imperative for the many students who are starting to take high school courses this summer so that when they complete the course, the high school will see the final grade and can make schedule adjustments if needed.

Steps for Changing Account:

1. Login into your FLVS account
2. Click the Virtual School Administrator link to enter VSA.
3. Click the menu (3 lines) at the top left of the screen next to FLVS.
4. Click Student Records then Academic Profile.
5. Click the dropdown to the right of the Physical School and select the new school.
6. Scroll to the bottom right and click SAVE
