ACT Non-College Reportable November 1st

This test is for 11th and 12th grade students who have not met the FSA Grade 10 ELA and/or the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement.

The ACT will be offered at Toco Creek on Tuesday, November 1st, 2022 to 11th and 12th grade students who have registered and paid.

The cost of the ACT exam is \$37.00. Payment can be made via [SchoolPay](#).

Payment is due by Wednesday, October 12th at 11:59pm.

Students who participate in this ACT-NCR will be granted accommodations (extended time) in hopes that the extra time will give the student a better chance to acquire the necessary ACT English and Reading subset score of 18 (average of the subtests) to meet the FSA Grade 10 ELA graduation requirement and/or ACT Math subtest score of 16 to meet Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement.

Because these accommodations are not officially approved by ACT, results earned during a non-college reportable ACT administration cannot be used for admissions or scholarship purposes. By submitting the payment to ACT-NCR, you are acknowledging that you understand these scores cannot be used for admissions and scholarship purposes.



This is the [second year that the University of North Florida has teamed up with the city of Palm Coast and Flagler Schools](#) to host the [Mednexus Innovation Challenge](#), a team-based entrepreneurship competition showcasing to regional high school students tasked to pitch their solutions to Florida's evolving healthcare needs.

It's a unique educational opportunity for students to receive scholarship prize money, mentoring by top university faculty, and to practice formulating and sharing innovative solutions to real needs within Florida's First Coast. The selected competition theme will be focused on improving sleep quality for young adults and all selected participating teams will receive free fit bits. While this Challenge is being cohosted by Palm Coast and being held at their City Hall, this is a regional event and open to other high school students to participate. 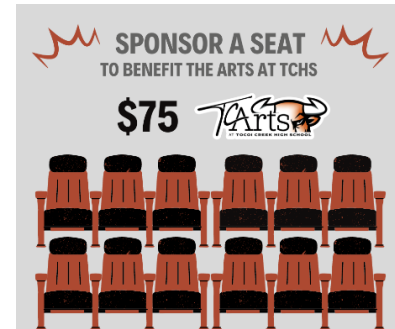
