Testing Information at TCHS

ACT Non-College Reportable November 1st

This test is for 11th and 12th grade students who have not met the FSA Grade 10 ELA and/or the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement.

The ACT will be offered at Toco Creek on Tuesday, November 1st, 2022 to 11th and 12th grade students who have registered and paid.

The cost of the ACT exam is \$37.00. Payment can be made via [SchoolPay](#).

Payment is due by Wednesday, October 12th at 11:59pm.

Students who participate in this ACT-NCR will be granted accommodations (extended time) in hopes that the extra time will give the student a better chance to acquire the necessary ACT English and Reading subset score of 18 (average of the subtests) to meet the FSA Grade 10 ELA graduation requirement and/or ACT Math subtest score of 16 to meet Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement.

Because these accommodations are not officially approved by ACT, results earned during a non-college reportable ACT administration cannot be used for admissions or scholarship purposes. By submitting the payment to ACT-NCR, you are acknowledging that you understand these scores cannot be used for admissions and scholarship purposes.



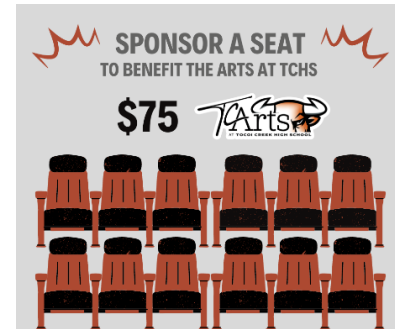

Driver Education Program Through the St. Johns County Tax Collectors Office

Phase I: Learner Permit Preparation (Taught at TCHS on selected mornings)

A classroom lecture designed to assist a student preparing to obtain a Learner Permit. The classes are conducted prior to school from 8am-9am for a total of 10 consecutive school days. On the last day, students will be administered the Learner Permit Knowledge Exam that is required to obtain a Learner Permit.
