 - Set up school based portal and confirm that all documents were received.
 - Receive admissions decision.
 - Follow enrollment steps (pay admissions deposit, submit residency documentation, signup for housing, meal plans, orientation, etc.)
- Apply for Financial Aid
 - Complete the FAFSA
- Apply for Bright Futures
 - Confirm that community service hours have been turned in to school counselor.
 - Send SAT/ACT scores to a Florida State University



ATTENTION RISING 11TH STUDENTS AND PARENTS:

Do you want your student to have an extra edge when applying to colleges? Do you want your student to learn critical thinking, presentation and evaluation skills to help them in any academic course? Consider encouraging your student to take AP Seminar!

In AP Seminar, students develop and practice the skills in research, collaboration, and communication that they will need in any academic discipline. Students investigate topics in a variety of subject areas, write research-based essays, and design and give presentations both individually and as part of a team.



Tocoi Creek High School is unique because we offer the AP Capstone program. Through this program, you can earn either the AP Capstone Diploma™ or the AP Seminar and Research Certificate™. When your student applies to college, they can denote these awards through the application process. Earning a Capstone Diploma makes students extremely competitive in the application process.

AP Capstone Awards are listed on AP score reports, and students who earn the diploma or certificate can view and print their award certificate from their online account. Awards are also included on any AP score report sent to colleges. Here are the requirements to earn an AP Capstone award:


- The AP Capstone Diploma is granted to students who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research and on 4 additional AP Exams of their choosing.
- The AP Seminar and Research Certificate is granted to students who earn scores of 3 or higher in both AP Seminar and AP Research.

TCHS CAREER ACADEMIES

Highlights from the week:

The Robotics team had a great end to their season, congratulations for all of your accomplishments this season! Students in the healthcare academy dissected sheep brains, cow eyes, and had a guest speaker to learn about healthcare programs at FCTC. Students in the Academy of Innovation in the Built Environment and Academy of Leadership in Emerging Technologies had two field trips this week, the SOAR STEM symposium and a tour of Innovative Construction Group and Pulte. Students in the Academy of Leadership in Emerging Technologies finally got their drones in the air!





YOUNG SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The Young Scholars Program (YSP) is a six week residential science and mathematics summer program for Florida high school students with significant potential for STEM careers. The program was developed in 1983 and is administered by the Office of STEM Teaching Activities in the College of Arts and Sciences at Florida State University.

YSP continues to be accessible to all qualified students who meet the eligibility requirements. As in the past, room, board, and tuition are provided for every admitted student, funded by Florida State University. Students with significant financial need may also apply for a supplemental program stipend to cover the cost of travel and books.

To be considered for acceptance, applicants must:

- · Have completed 11th grade in a Florida public or private high school
- · Have scored in the 90th percentile or better in Math on a nationally standardized exam
- Be able to commit for the entire six weeks of the program (no exceptions will be made for travel to other summer internship opportunities, camps, Mu Alpha Theta, etc.)
- · Maintain a permanent residence in the State of Florida
- · Maintain at least a 3.0 GPA (unweighted)
- · Be enrolled in or have completed Pre-Calculus

Important Deadlines:

- January 1: Application available online (on or before this day)
- February 15: Application and Recommendations deadline
- May 15: Admission decisions finalized (on or before this day)



Program Dates for 2023:

YSP will run from June 11-July 22, 2023.






