### ACADEMY OF LEADERSHIP IN EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES

The drones have made their way to the air! Students in level one are continuing to progress on their drone safety certification and have finally taken flight. Students have been invited to attend a field trip on March 7th to the Mayport Naval Base to tour their unmanned squadron and see everything they've been learning in class put into action. Students also enjoyed a field trip to tour Solar Stik and see manufacturing right here in St. Augustine, as well as join our Built Environment students at Construction & Career Days.

### ACADEMY OF INNOVATION IN THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

50 students were able to have the experience of a lifetime thanks to Innovative Construction Group and Pulte. Students started their day by touring ICG's plant where they got to see how walls, floors, and roof trusses get prefabricated at the plant. Students then went to the Pulte home office to learn about procurement, land acquisition, and home design. The day ended with a tour of homes being built at Del Webb Nocatee and students were able to see the roof trusses get installed as well as see homes in different stages of construction.





### FLAGLER HEALTH + ACADEMY OF FUTURE HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

Students in Health Science Foundations were able to take a field trip to Nemours Children's Health in Jacksonville and about dozens of different healthcare careers and opportunities. Students toured the oncology & hematology floor, talked to volunteer services, learned about the business side of healthcare, and met with orthopedics to tour the X-Ray machines and learn about cast removal.

Academy students must keep their Academy course semester grade at a 70% or higher. If a student's semester grade is not at least a 70%, a letter will be sent home informing the student and their parent that they are on Academy Academic Probation for the following semester. Students must earn at least a 70% or higher for the following semester to remain in the Academy. If the student earns a grade lower than a 70% for two semesters in a row, that student is released from the Career Academy and cannot re-enroll at any time. If a student needs any academic help, they can get FREE tutoring in any subject from the National Honor Society.
