

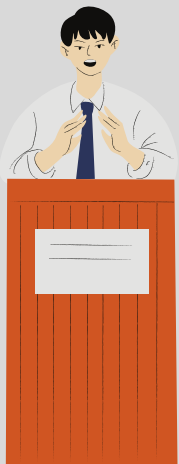

NEWSWORTHY TOROS

FOUR ATHLETIC TRAINING STUDENTS WERE SELECTED TO GO PARTAKE IN JSMP (JACKSONVILLE SPORTS MEDICINE PROGRAM) SPORTS INJURY SYMPOSIUM AT THE JAGS STADIUM: SAVANNAH MALOTA, KAYCEE HUFF, ERIN BASTOW, AND ANA WILLETS. THESE FOUR STUDENTS WERE SELECTED OUT OF DUVAL, ST JOHNS, NASSAU, FLAGLER, AND VOLUSIA COUNTY STUDENTS WHERE THEY HAD TO APPLY TO BE CONSIDERED. THEY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN ABOUT HEAD INJURIES, HEAT RELATED INJURIES, SPORT REHABILITATION, SPORT NUTRITION, STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING, WERE TAUGHT HOW TO TAPE, AND FINISHED UP WITH BEING TAUGHT CPR AND FIRST AID. THEY EVEN GOT A TOUR OF THE JAGS LOCKER ROOM AS WELL AND THEIR WEIGHT ROOM! THEY HAD AN ABSOLUTE BLAST AND STATED THEY HOPE THEY ARE SELECTED AGAIN TO GO NEXT YEAR.

ON SATURDAY, THEY WENT AND VOLUNTEERED WITH THE "WHO WE PLAY FOR ORGANIZATION", WHICH OFFERS FREE EKG SCREENINGS TO ATHLETES AS PART OF THEIR ATHLETIC PHYSICALS TO DETECT ANY HEART ABNORMALITIES A TYPICAL PHYSICAL SCREENING WOULD NOT CATCH. Congratulations to the 94 students who earned an industry certification in our first round of testing. The next round of testing will take place on April 25th and will include all students in a CTE course with the exception of the healthcare academy, this includes Digital Video Technologies, Digital Art Imaging, the Academy of Innovation in the Built Environment (all levels), the Academy of Leadership in Emerging Technologies (level 2 only), and Foundations of Programming.

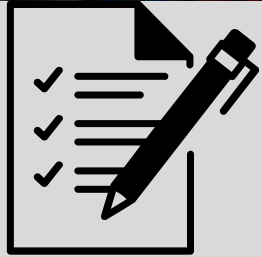

- College Admissions
 - Set up school based portal and confirm that all documents were received.
 - Receive admissions decision.
 - Follow enrollment steps (pay admissions deposit, submit residency documentation, signup for housing, meal plans, orientation, etc.)
- Apply for Financial Aid
 - Complete the FAFSA
- Apply for Bright Futures
 - Confirm that community service hours have been turned in to school counselor.
 - Send SAT/ACT scores to a Florida State University
