Do you love animals? Want to make a difference in your community?

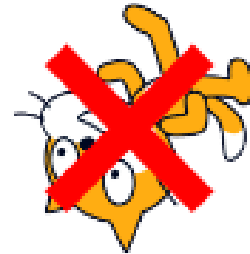
Join the Cause for Paws after school club! We are a group of students who are passionate about animals and want to help them find loving homes.
