<u>History Made at TCHS! First EVER - National Merit</u> <u>Finalist and Commended Scholar Announced!</u>

The St. Johns County School District had 35 seniors qualify as National Merit Semifinalists for 2024. These students placed among the top 1% of all students in the country taking the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT)/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test given annually to high school juniors.

TCHS is PROUD to announce the following Toros for their accomplishments:

- Ms. Vidharthi Jagadish Kumar National Merit Finalist
 - Quite the academic accomplishment, of more than 16,000 of the high scorers, representing less than 1% of the nation's high school graduating seniors, will qualify as Semifinalists. Only Semifinalists will have an opportunity to advance in the competition for Merit Scholarship® awards.
 - Vidharthi is Tocoi's very first National Merit Scholar Semi-Finalist
 - We are optimistic that Vidharthi will attain Finalist Status this spring and are so proud of her accomplishments thus far, whatever the outcome.

• Ms. Catalina Martinez-Whittingham -Commended Scholar

 In September 2024, more than two-thirds (about 34,000) of the high scorers will be designated Commended Students. This accounts for approximately 2-3% of the overall student testing population. Catalina is Tocoi's first National Merit Commended Scholar

CHAPTER 3: RENEWAL ELIGIBILITY, INCLUDES:

- Reinstatement/Restoration Requirements.

Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholarship (BFFMS) students enrolled in an associate degree program at a Florida College System (FCS) institution receive 100 percent of tuition and specific fees. Upon completing an associate degree, a student may use his or her award to pursue a baccalaureate degree and receive 75 percent of tuition and specific fees.

PRIVATE SCHOLARSHIPS:

Many scholarship committees are looking for students who have the ability to communicate effectively in writing. Essays are an excellent way for scholarship judges to choose the most qualified candidates. Tips for writing the essay include:

- <u>Giving yourself time</u> Quality essays take time;
- <u>Following directions</u> Word count and font size may be eligibility requirements;
- Focusing on the topic Answer the question that is being asked;
- <u>Proofreading and editing your work</u> Be clear, concise, and correct any errors; and
- <u>Getting feedback</u> Ask family or counselors to read your essay and provide feedback.

ACCOUNT OF A

School Counselors attended our annual training with the State University Admission Directors, ACT/SAT/CLT representatives, and the Department of Education. There are a lot of updates this year that we are anxious to share with you and your students.

We have dispersed this information in the following ways:

Individual Senior Meetings: Counselors met with every senior individually. The counselors discussed graduation requirements and post-secondary planning with each student.

Classroom Guidance:

Website: The following sections of the website have received significant updates:

<u>Bright Futures</u>- Includes updated Bright Futures test score requirements for the class of 2024 and 2025. In addition, it specifies that community service hours and paid service hours can now be combined to reach the 100 hour requirement. Bright Futures has also extended the deadline to submit standardized test scores to the August 31st after graduation!

<u>Testing for College</u>- Includes an introduction to the Classic Learning Test (CLT) which is an online exam that can be taken from home and used for Bright Futures, College Admissions, and to meet high school graduation testing requirements! There is also additional information about the ACT, PERT, PSAT, and SAT exams.

<u>Graduation Requirements</u> - Includes notification that the on-line course requirement has been removed as a graduation requirement for all grade levels as well as NEW graduation requirements for students entering high school in the 23-24 school year and beyond.

<u>Counselor Videos</u>- Includes an updated Toro Academic Handbook which walks students 8-12th grade through navigating the high school and post-secondary process. It also has updated guides for both the Florida Private Schools and Florida State Universities which includes average accepted GPA's and test scores all in one place!


