Teaching Academy spent a full day at Mill Creek where they were able to put their lesson planning and delivery skills to use within their assigned classroom.




WELCOME TO TOCOI CREEK HIGH SCHOOL'S CAREER ACADEMIES


Health Sciences 2 students have been practicing blood pressure readings.

CERTIFICATION TESTING UPDATE

As a certified testing center, the certification exams administered at TCHS are proctored through Certiport, an independent testing platform. Students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 may apply for accommodations through Certiport. Because it is an outside testing company, like ACT or SAT, accommodations, such as extended time, must be applied for and implemented to the individual student's testing platform by Certiport. The school cannot request these services, the student and their legal guardian (if student is under 18) must submit the request directly to Certiport. Accommodations are granted by Certiport annually, so even if your student was granted accommodations for testing in the 2022-2023 school year, the application must be submitted again for the 2023-2024 school year to ensure that accommodations are provided at the time your student tests.


CLASSROOM HAPPENINGS
