CERTIFICATION TESTING UPDATE

As a certified testing center, the certification exams administered at TCHS are proctored through Certiport, an independent testing platform. Students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 may apply for accommodations through Certiport. Because it is an outside testing company, like ACT or SAT, accommodations, such as extended time, must be applied for and implemented to the individual student's testing platform by Certiport. The school cannot request these services, the student and their legal guardian (if student is under 18) must submit the request directly to Certiport. Accommodations are granted by Certiport annually, so even if your student was granted accommodations for testing in the 2022-2023 school year, the application must be submitted again for the 2023-2024 school year to ensure that accommodations are provided at the time your student tests.

ACADEMY OF LEADERSHIP IN EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES

Robotic Applications Capstone is finishing up their Micropython code for a web enabled smart sprinkler controller. The class has also covered all the basic functions of the Autodesk Inventor 3D modeling program. Over the next quarter we will perfect our skills and learn advanced functions in Inventor as we progress towards the certification exam in January. We are also getting ready to start our addressable LED projects. Students will have the opportunity to build and program their own LED board! They are also able to bring their own materials in and build a project that they are allowed to keep.

Foundations of Robotics has progressed through a series of twelve labs where students explore the components of robots through building circuits using individual components. Over the next few weeks students will build a complex circuit with multiple components. Students are also going to build hydraulically actuated robot arms as we study power systems.

Robotics Club is fast approaching our first official competition on Saturday November 4th! The robots are progressing, and all seem to be able to move around the field. All teams are working hard to build functioning arms, grippers, and paper airplane launchers. We finally received our partial field for the teams to practice.


