

New Assessment for Graduation and Bright Futures Qualification

The Classic Learning Test (CLT) is an online college entrance exam for 11th and 12th grade students. Thanks to recent legislation, the CLT can now be used to satisfy State of Florida graduation testing requirements, qualify students for Bright Futures and is recognized by many universities and colleges. Just like the SAT and the ACT, students can use a score on the CLT to meet assessment graduation requirements as specified in Rule 6A-1.09422. Grade 10 ELA Concordant Scores - Available for students who entered grade 9 in 2020-21 and beyond:

CLT Verbal Reasoning and Grammar/Writing sections sum 36

The CLT has primarily been taken remotely (at home) but can also be given at schools. A list of test dates as well as other test related deadlines can be accessed <u>here</u>.

Tocoi Creek is highly considering conducting the online version of the CLT on Thursday, February 15th, during the school day. If you would be interested in this opportunity, please complete <u>this</u> quick response form so we can gauge interest. If TCHS does run the CLT on February 15th, students would be responsible for submitting payment prior to registration.

GENERAL SCHOOL INFO

SCHOOLOGY PARENT ACCESS

Schoology Parent Access allows parents to easily see Schoology information for all of their children in one place.

If you have previously signed up for Schoology Parent Access for your child, you do not need to do so again. If you have not created a Schoology Parent Access Account or need to add a child to your account, please follow these instructions. Please note: If you forget your Schoology Parent Access Account password, you will need to follow the instructions provided on the Schoology.com site to reset or retrieve your password. The St Johns County School District does not have access to parent account passwords.

You will need to find the Schoology Parent Access Code for your Child. This is located in HAC under "Registration" and then "Additional Information"

If you have never used Schoology Parent Access:

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Click on "Sign Up"
- 3) Click on "Parent"
- 4) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code from HAC
- 5) Click "Continue"
- 6) Type your information (not your child's information) in the boxes.
- 7) Check the appropriate boxes at that bottom of your information
- 8) Click "Register"
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child's information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child's name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. Click on the down arrow near your name on the right of the screen. Scroll down and click "add child." Type in the access code for that child (provided to you by your child's school). Click "Use Code." You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts.

If you already have a Schoology Parent Access account (created for a child at another SJCSD school):

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Login with the information you used to create the account
- 3) Click on the down arrow near your name on the right side of the screen
- 4) Click on "add child"
- 5) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code that can be found in HAC
- 6) Click "Use Code"

7) You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts by going to the drop down arrow and selecting the child's account you wish to view.

DRESS CODE POLICY


Expectation: Student clothing choices are both respectful of the school community and are appropriate for an educational environment.



Dress Code Standards:

- Clothing must cover areas from one armpit to the other armpit, down to mid-thigh. Tops must have shoulder straps.
 - Examples of Violations:
 - Garments worn on the upper half of the body that are low cut and revealing.
 - Tube top or tube top without arm cuffs
 - Undergarments do not count as "straps"
 - Shirts short enough to expose midriff
 - Sagging pants. All pants must be worn around the waist.
 - Garments worn on the lower half of the body must not be shorter than mid-thigh or have holes exposing skin above midthing.
- See-through of mesh garments must be worn with opaque clothing over it
 or underneath that meets the standards for clothing coverage.
- Shoes must be worn at all times and should be safe for travel around campus. Backless shoes are allowed; however, slippers are not permitted.
- Hats/Hoods may not be worn inside the building.
- No clothing or accessory advertising alcohol, drugs, weapons, nudity, profanity, etc.

Students who violate the dress code will be asked to change and progressive discipline will follow. Level 2: defiance/disrespect







GUIDANCE INFORMATION

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The School Counseling Team will be hosting Dual Enrollment Information Sessions during Toro Time on December 6 & 20.

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment is a program that allows students to take college level courses at St. Johns River State College and earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. The credits that students earn must be applicable toward high school graduation and be applicable toward an Associate or Baccalaureate degree.

Who is eligible for Dual Enrollment?

• Students with a 3.0 or higher UNWEIGHTED GPA Students with qualifying test scores on the ACT, SAT, or PERT (see qualifying test scores <u>here.</u>

What do I do if I'm interested?

- Attend one of the Toro Time Sessions on December 6 & 20th (These sessions are for STUDENTS. A parent presentation will be posted on the website after the presentation).
- Join the Dual Enrollment Schoology group: RCGS-QGPH-RZCG6
- Confirm your eligibility.
- Tell your school counselor when you are selecting your courses for next year.

Important things to consider:

- The student will need transportation to and from the college campus.
- Dual Enrollment students are considered college students. St. Johns River State College is a separate school from TCHS. Their professors do not communicate with parents or school counselors regarding assignments and grades. The do not input grades in HAC or follow TCHS test retake policies. Students who receive TCHS accommodations will need to apply and are not guaranteed to receive accommodations through St. Johns River State College.
- All grades earned are a part of the student's permanent college transcript. If students struggle in a course and withdraw, they will earn a W on their transcript which can have negative implications for college admissions, financial aid eligibility, and place students on Bright Futures and other scholarship probation once they are in college.
- Dual Enrollment students must be responsible and independent learners. THE STUDENT needs to make sure that they meet ALL DEADLINES (application, test scores, course registration, book rental, etc) by checking for updates in the Dual Enrollment Schoology group and their SJR email daily.

GUIDANCE INFO FOR SENIORS

BRIGHT FUTURES SENIOR UPDATE:



Bright Futures allows students to "lock in" the Bright Futures scholarship after the 1st semester of their senior year. Students that lock in the Medallion Level award can continue to improve their GPA, retake their standardized tests, and/or submit additional community service hours to be re-evaluated for the Academic Level award at the end of the school year. The advantage of locking in the scholarship is that students can not lose the scholarship once it is locked in if their GPA drops and the college will be able to process their scholarship package sooner.

To lock in the scholarship, students MUST do the following prior to December 21st:

- Apply! Application instructions are available here
- Submit their pay stubs and/or community service letters and reflection sheets to the guidance office. Community service instructions are available <u>here.</u>
- Submit their qualifying test scores to at least one public Florida university.
- Have a minimum of a 3.0 BRIGHT FUTURES GPA.

Students that do not lock in the scholarship after the first semester can still apply and be evaluated again after graduation. Students have until August 31st following their senior year to continue to retake the ACT, SAT, or CLT to get qualifying test scores and graduation day to submit their community service/ paid work hours.




