## GUIDANCE INFORMATION

This week begins phase 2 of our schedule registration process for the 24-25 school year. Our school counseling team will be meeting with every single student individually between January 25th and spring break to go over their class selections for next year. As a result, students and parents do not need to schedule individual appointments with counselors. Students will be seen individually during their English class. If your child is absent, does not have an English class, or the counselor runs out of time to meet during the scheduled class time, your child will receive a pass to meet with their counselor during a scheduled make-up day.

9th grade students received their course verification forms through their English classes this past week. Please use the weekend to review their course recommendations from their teachers as well as the electives that they previously selected. If you want to make any changes or have questions, you can notate that on the form so your child's counselor can discuss the topics during their meeting. If you would like to participate in the meeting by phone, please make sure that your student brings their phone to their meeting.

- Review the course verification form as a family once it is received.
- List any questions, concerns, or change requests on the bottom portion of the form to be reviewed with the counselor.
- Don't forget to bring the form back to school on the day of your appointment.

Our counseling team would also like to request your patience during this scheduling season. In order to meet with every student, school counselors are outside of their offices for the entire school day. As a result, our scheduling links will show us as mostly unavailable and response time to emails and voicemails will be slower than normal. We will continue to have the first-floor guidance office available for students in crisis as well as mental health support whenever needed.

#### **CERTIFICATION TESTING UPDATE**

As a certified testing center, the certification exams administered at TCHS are proctored through Certiport, an independent testing platform. Students with an **Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504** may apply for accommodations through Certiport. Because it is an outside testing company, like ACT or SAT, accommodations, such as extended time, must be applied for and implemented to the individual student's testing platform by Certiport. The school cannot request these services, the student and their legal guardian (if student is under 18) must submit the request directly to Certiport. Accommodations are granted by Certiport annually, so even if your student was granted accommodations for testing in the 2022-2023 school year, the application must be submitted again for the 2023-2024 school year to ensure that accommodations are provided at the time your student tests.

## GENERAL SCHOOL INFO

#### **SCHOOLOGY PARENT ACCESS**

Schoology Parent Access allows parents to easily see Schoology information for all of their children in one place.

If you have previously signed up for Schoology Parent Access for your child, you do not need to do so again. If you have not created a Schoology Parent Access Account or need to add a child to your account, please follow these instructions. Please note: If you forget your Schoology Parent Access Account password, you will need to follow the instructions provided on the Schoology.com site to reset or retrieve your password. The St Johns County School District does not have access to parent account passwords.

You will need to find the Schoology Parent Access Code for your Child. This is located in HAC under "Registration" and then "Additional Information"

If you have never used Schoology Parent Access:

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Click on "Sign Up"
- 3) Click on "Parent"
- 4) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code from HAC
- 5) Click "Continue"
- 6) Type your information (not your child's information) in the boxes.
- 7) Check the appropriate boxes at that bottom of your information
- 8) Click "Register"
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child's information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child's name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. Click on the down arrow near your name on the right of the screen. Scroll down and click "add child." Type in the access code for that child (provided to you by your child's school). Click "Use Code." You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts.

If you already have a Schoology Parent Access account (created for a child at another SJCSD school):

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Login with the information you used to create the account
- 3) Click on the down arrow near your name on the right side of the screen
- 4) Click on "add child"
- 5) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code that can be found in HAC
- 6) Click "Use Code"

7) You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts by going to the drop down arrow and selecting the child's account you wish to view.
