Q: How much is a parking pass for the 24-25 school year?

A: A parking pass is \$125. These passes are non-refundable.

Q: Can Sophomores and/or Freshmen park on campus?

A: No, TCHS will **NOT** issue parking passes for Freshmen or Sophomore students.

Q: Can two students share a parking pass?

A: No. Siblings are the only students who can share a parking pass.

Q: Will all students who apply for parking receive a parking pass?

A: No. Due to the number of Juniors/Seniors, TCHS cannot accommodate parking for all students who apply.

Q: Will there be a waitlist for students for Juniors and Seniors who were unable to secure a parking pass? A: Yes. There will be a waitlist sign-up prior to start of the 2024-2025 school year and will be used when spots become available.

Q: Will there painted parking spots for Seniors?

A: No. However, there will be an opportunity for Seniors to participate in a painting opportunity through TCHS Arts boosters (Information to be released soon.)

Q: Will students be allowed to park on campus before/after school if they do not have a parking pass?

A: Yes. Students who need to be on campus before/after school hours may park on campus but must move vehicle during school hours (9:00am – 4:00pm).

Q: Can students park at Publix or other businesses?

A: No. TCHS has no control over outside parking. It is not recommended to park in these areas.

Q: Does TCHS offer temporary parking passes?

A: No. All students & parents are encouraged to contact the school for special circumstances.
