Senior Updates:

Bright Futures:

- Florida's Bright Futures Scholarship System has released the student early evaluation report for the Class of 2024. This report displays student progress towards achieving a Bright Futures award. Reports are available for pick up from your student's school counselor. Students also received an eligibility or ineligibility determination award status posted in their FFAA online account.
- Students that are still trying to meet graduation requirement have until the last day of school to submit their community service hours. Community service guidelines, forms, and opportunities are available on the school counseling portion of the TCHS website. Students have until August to submit qualifying test scores to one of the 12 state universities. Qualifying scores and information about test registration and prep is [available here](#).

College Admissions:

Students should be finalizing their college choices by now. Most schools require students to decide on the school they plan to attend by May 1st (some schools have issued extensions this year). Make sure that you have logged into your online account with your school and are completing all of the steps listed there to finalize your enrollment. Most schools will require an admissions deposit, housing (if living on campus), orientation sign up, medical forms, financial aid, a final transcript, and other miscellaneous items. Students will be completing a senior survey as part of their senior debt day experience and will let us know where to send their final transcript after graduation at that time.

- All Juniors should have just taken the ACT in March. If you haven't taken the SAT yet, you should try that test too! It's not uncommon for students to not like their first round of test scores. Take both tests (and even the CLT) and see which one you like the most. Get some test prep and keep working to get that desired test score! - It is time to narrow down your college list! You can do the “find your fit” activity in Naviance if you are still trying to find the colleges that might be right for you. Now is a great time to visit schools and see them first hand. The schools will open up their application portals in July and August and will start accepting applications as early as September. A lot of the schools have Fall deadlines for Early Action, Scholarships, etc so you want to make sure you are ready to apply (test scores and all!) by Fall!

The University of North Florida (UNF) has published it's “Apply in July” information for this summer. This is a great opportunity for students to lock in a college acceptance ahead of their senior year. The spaces fill up quickly, so don't delay. [Register here!](#)

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program

- Submit a complete and error-free Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application (no later than August 31, 2024);
- Complete the required coursework (by high school graduation);
- Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework;
- Complete the required number of volunteer/paid hours (by established deadline); and
- Achieve the required college entrance exam score for tests taken no later than August 31, 2024. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook for complete program requirements: www.floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org/SAPBFMAIN/SAPBFMAIN.
- Although ACT[®], CLT[®], and SAT[®] may offer test dates beyond August 2024, final evaluations for 2024 graduating seniors will only consider test dates for exams taken no later than August 31, 2024, for the Bright Futures Scholarship Programs authorized by rule 6A-20.028, Florida Administrative Code.

Bright Futures Summer Funding:

- Funding is available during the summer term for Bright Futures Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) and Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS). Funding is only available if the postsecondary institution allows an FAS/FMS student to enroll as a degree-seeking student during the summer term. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook, Chapter 2 for more information.

For those of you attending a postsecondary institution for the first time this summer or fall semester, your head must be filled with questions and thoughts about what to expect. College is an exciting place, but it can be complete chaos if you are not prepared. Don't worry, we have your back! Complete this checklist and get a jump start on the right path.

- Open a savings account and start saving.
- Research your college. Find out more about different activities and clubs they are known for and student organizations offered on campus.
- Register for classes. Between orientation or just an appointment with an advisor, make sure you register for classes by the deadline.
- Handle all financial aid matters before the start of your first

class. It's easy to forget about or simply avoid, but this is one way that you can really get messed up.

- Go shopping! Get all of the things you'll need for your classes, your dorm room, or your new wardrobe. Look into your upcoming booklist and research affordable options.
- Research college majors. Whether you're pretty sure what your path is or you have no idea, do some research. Look up course list, graduation rate, job expectancy, income level, etc. Narrow it down to a few that interest you and be ready to talk to an advisor.

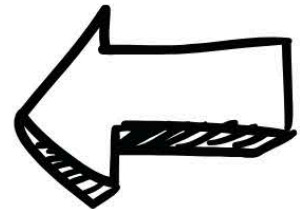
CERTIFICATION TESTING UPDATE

As a certified testing center, the certification exams administered at TCHS are proctored through Certiport, an independent testing platform. Students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 may apply for accommodations through Certiport. Because it is an outside testing company, like ACT or SAT, accommodations, such as extended time, must be applied for and implemented to the individual student's testing platform by Certiport. The school cannot request these services, the student and their legal guardian (if student is under 18) must submit the request directly to Certiport. Accommodations are granted by Certiport annually, so even if your student was granted accommodations for testing in the 2022-2023 school year, the application must be submitted again for the 2023-2024 school year to ensure that accommodations are provided at the time your student tests.

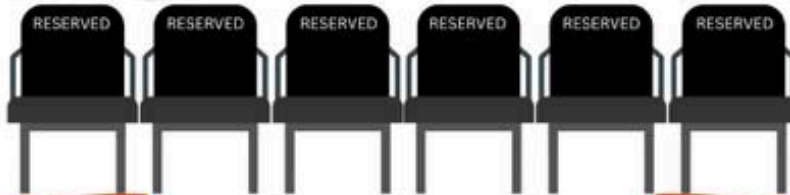

GENERAL SCHOOL INFO

SCHOOLGY PARENT ACCESS

Schoology Parent Access allows parents to easily see Schoology information for all of their children in one place.

If you have previously signed up for Schoology Parent Access for your child, you do not need to do so again. If you have not created a Schoology Parent Access Account or need to add a child to your account, please follow these instructions. Please note: If you forget your Schoology Parent Access Account password, you will need to follow the instructions provided on the Schoology.com site to reset or retrieve your password. The St Johns County School District does not have access to parent account passwords.

You will need to find the Schoology Parent Access Code for your Child. This is located in HAC under “Registration” and then “Additional Information”

If you have never used Schoology Parent Access:

- 1) Go to www.schoology.com
- 2) Click on “Sign Up”
- 3) Click on “Parent”
- 4) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code from HAC
- 5) Click “Continue”
- 6) Type your information (not your child’s information) in the boxes.
- 7) Check the appropriate boxes at that bottom of your information
- 8) Click “Register”
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child’s information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child’s name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. Click on the down arrow near your name on the right of the screen. Scroll down and click “add child.” Type in the access code for that child (provided to you by your child’s school). Click “Use Code.” You can now easily switch between your children’s Schoology accounts.

If you already have a Schoology Parent Access account (created for a child at another SJCS D school):

- 1) Go to www.schoology.com
- 2) Login with the information you used to create the account
- 3) Click on the down arrow near your name on the right side of the screen
- 4) Click on “add child”
- 5) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code that can be found in HAC
- 6) Click “Use Code”
- 7) You can now easily switch between your children’s Schoology accounts by going to the drop down arrow and selecting the child’s account you wish to view.
