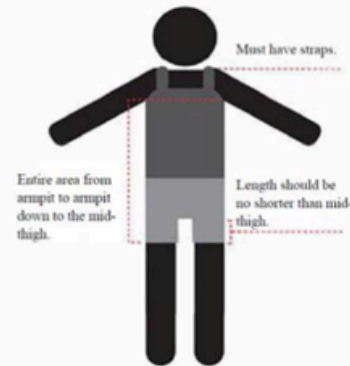
SCHOOL SHOPPING TIPS

Are there any additional fees for specific classes?

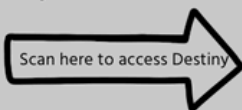

NEW FAMILY DECODERS FOR TCHS LANGUAGE

The Bull Pen - This is your weekly news feed that will have everything accessible in a digital format. Past publications can be found on the TCHS website. This is a BIG document that will have ALL that is needed for a successful year.

TCHS Website - Your “one-stop-shop” for everything OFFICAL you need to know about TCHS. Need a calendar of events? Want to talk to your Toro’s counselor? Need to know information about clubs, activities, or events? [The TCHS website is your spot!](#)

HAC - Home Access Center is the digital hub for grades, student information, view bus stop information, where interims and report cards are posted.

Freshman Day - August 1st - This is a special day where your 9th Grade Toro gets to meet their Junior or Senior assigned mentor, tour the school, meet staff, and learn how to be a Toro. This is a “drop and go” activity for Toros only (no parents allowed). If you have a new Toro coming to TCHS

Toro RoundUP - Beginning of the school year event, before school starts, where parents and students can walk their schedule, purchase spirit wear, get parking passes (11th and 12th grade students only who have been selected), get lockers, meet staff, and get oriented for the new year. All family members are invited. Teachers will **not** be assessable during these events.

Meet the Teacher - August 9th from 8am-11am students and families can walk their schedule and go inside each of their classes. This is a self-timed event where families can come and go as needed.

Schoology - Digital platform that students use to interact with each teacher, store documents, message school personnel, and receive updates and important reminders. Students are automatically enrolled and can access from any device that connects to the net.

AUP - Acceptable Use Policy - this document is the “**rule book for using electronic devices/platforms**” for the St. Johns County School District. All staff, students, and visitors must acknowledge/sign their AUP at the beginning of each year prior to utilizing any digital resource at school. A digital link will be provided to each student/family within the first few days of school.

RSV - Returning Student Verification - Process that parents must do each year at the beginning of each school year to verify their residency, school location, and general family contact information.

Digital ID by Leonard’s - All students who utilize a digital smart phone are expected to download the Digital ID by Leonard’s app to receive special messages, purchase a lunch, check out media materials, and to scan into/out of school. The app can be located in the Apple or Google Stores.

The Hub - The TCHS Media Center found on floor 2 of Building 1 where Toros can check out books, digital media, print documents, or log into a computer. The Hub also has a coffee shop where Toros can get the latest offerings of specialty drinks.

GoFan - Digital platform where students can purchase tickets to athletic and social events. NEW this year, students can purchase an ALL ACCESS sports pass for \$75 in GoFan. [Click HERE for more information.](#)

School Pay - Digital pay portal that parents/students can access to purchase dance tickets, pay for Fair Share, or school fees. Parents can set up an account for quick and consistent access, or pay as a guest as needed.

Pay Pams - Digital portal where parents can load, monitor, and/or restrict lunch account activities. Want to set limits or pay automatically when funds become low..PayPams is your portal. Parents are encouraged to set this process up digitally even if they want to have their child pay with cash/check as you will still get the same ability to monitor the account. Fortify Florida - Digital platform where anyone can anonymously report any threat to students, schools, or school realated activities. [Click HERE for more information on FortifyFL](#)

CLEVER - Digital portal that students will use to access Schoology, Office 365, Online Textbooks, and other Links for Students.

CLASS OF 2025 TRANSCRIPT INFO

Class of 2025- Are you ready to apply to college?!

This is an exciting time for you and we know that many of you are eager to get started. Unfortunately, we are in a transition period with our transcript submission system. As of June 30, 2024, we are no longer able to send transcripts via Naviance. Our new transcript system will roll out this Fall. In the interim we are only able to send transcripts electronically to schools inside the state of Florida. If you are looking to apply out of state, you will need to wait until our new system rolls out or request a paper copy of your transcript to mail to the institution. The new system will have detailed instructions on our website to assist students already working on their college applications once it is ready. Our school counseling team will be visiting senior English classes during the first month of school to go over the new system with seniors and teach them how to use it. School counselors will also be hosting Toro Time sessions in September to assist students with their college applications. We hope your students are getting those test scores up and narrowing down those college lists. We look forward to helping finalize those applications this Fall!

CLICK THE MENU (3 LINES) AT THE TOP LEFT OF THE SCREEN NEXT TO FLVS.

CLICK STUDENT RECORDS THEN ACADEMIC PROFILE.

CLICK THE DROPDOWN TO THE RIGHT OF THE PHYSICAL SCHOOL AND SELECT THE NEW SCHOOL.

SCROLL TO THE BOTTOM RIGHT AND CLICK SAVE.

Your school counseling team is looking forward to enjoying their summer vacation with you!

While our counseling team enjoys their summer break, we hope that you will take advantage of the many resources on our [school counseling website](#).

We particularly want to draw your attention to our [23-24 Toro Guide](#) which has a lot of information that can guide you through high school and your post-secondary plans.

If you are in need of information from a counselor this summer, please reach out via email to our school counseling Team Lead Linda Smith (Linda.M.Smith@stjohns.k12.fl.us). She will be working part time this summer and will respond to you as soon as she is available.

To assist you in advance, we have a few reminders for common summer questions:

- 1. Dual Enrollment:** Dual Enrollment students should check their “concise student schedule” to confirm their Fall course enrollment. Students not enrolled in their requested courses should check their email for communication from SJR. If any additional information needs to be submitted, reach out to school counselors Laura Kuhel or Linda Smith. We are no longer accepting registration paperwork for NEW Dual Enrollment students.
- 2. Schedule Changes:** We are no longer accepting schedule changes for the 24-25 school year. Schedules will be available for preview in HAC on July 24-25th and a link will be available for any scheduling errors at that time.
- 3. Summer School:** Parents of students recommended for summer school should have received an email from their student’s counselor. Those parents will receive additional communication via school messenger from the district office. Summer school will run from May 30-June 21st. Any other parent wanting their student to take courses over the summer should request those courses through www.flvs.net and request approval from Linda Smith. Note that students can only retake classes that they earned a “D” or “F” and can not request courses that are already on their 24-25 schedule at school.

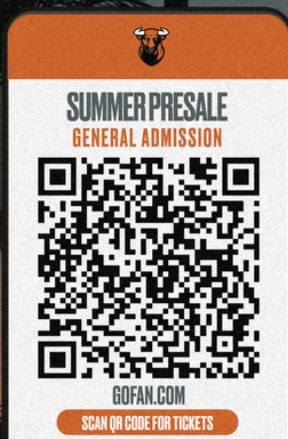

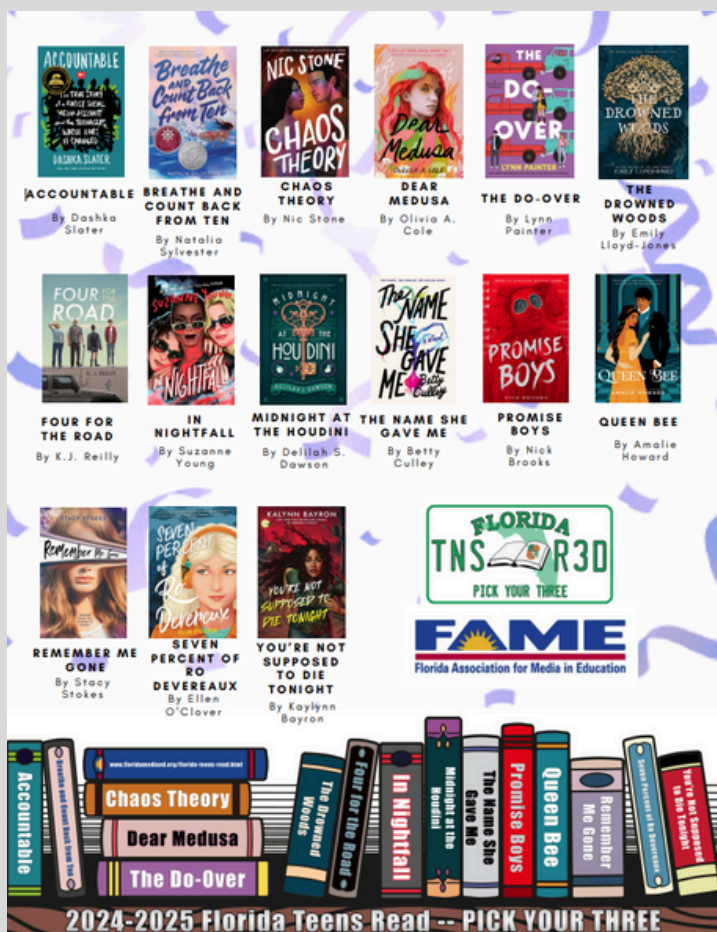
The Destiny Discover App is the easiest way to access TCHS library resources

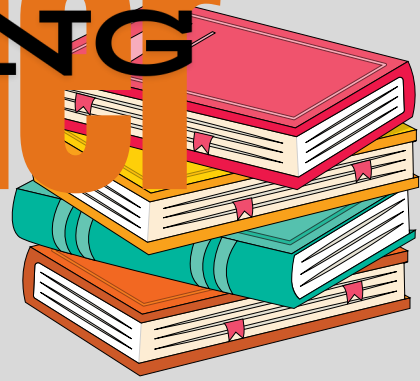
About the program:

The Florida Teens Read (FTR) program is a student-choice reading award program to determine which YA book wins the annual award as the favorite of teens in Florida. The reading list is comprised of fifteen titles that have been chosen by a committee of fourteen school librarians specifically to engage high school students (grades 9 through 12) in reading and reflect their interests as well as represent a variety of genres, formats, reading levels, viewpoints, and ethnic and cultural perspectives.

The Florida Teens Read program is designed to entice teens to read. In order to engage their interest and to provide a spur to critical thinking, the book selections include those that may involve sensitive issues. The content of some of the titles may be more mature than younger students may have previously encountered. Please recognize that this is a voluntary reading program. Schoology Parent Access allows parents to easily see Schoology information for all of their children in one place.

If you have previously signed up for Schoology Parent Access for your child, you do not need to do so again. If you have not created a Schoology Parent Access Account or need to add a child to your account, please follow these instructions. Please note: If you forget your Schoology Parent Access Account password, you will need to follow the instructions provided on the Schoology.com site to reset or retrieve your password. The St Johns County School District does not have access to parent account passwords.

You will need to find the Schoology Parent Access Code for your Child. This is located in HAC under “Registration” and then “Additional Information”

If you have never used Schoology Parent Access:

- 1) Go to www.schoology.com
- 2) Click on “Sign Up”
- 3) Click on “Parent”
- 4) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code from HAC
- 5) Click “Continue”
- 6) Type your information (not your child’s information) in the boxes.
- 7) Check the appropriate boxes at that bottom of your information
- 8) Click “Register”
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child’s information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child’s name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. Click on the down arrow near your name on the right of the screen. Scroll down and click “add child.” Type in the access code for that child (provided to you by your child’s school). Click “Use Code.” You can now easily switch between your children’s Schoology accounts.

If you already have a Schoology Parent Access account (created for a child at another SJCS D school):

- 1) Go to www.schoology.com
- 2) Login with the information you used to create the account
- 3) Click on the down arrow near your name on the right side of the screen
- 4) Click on “add child”
- 5) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code that can be found in HAC
- 6) Click “Use Code”
- 7) You can now easily switch between your children’s Schoology accounts by going to the drop down arrow and selecting the child’s account you wish to view.
