

- All Non TCHS guest attending Prom will need to complete the Prom Guest Application and Identification.


## SEMOR CLEARANCE DAY






## Senior Survey



# Clearance Day


- Completed clearance forms should be brought to school on Clearance Day –

- If you owe a debt you will need to clear that before clearance day








# Graduation Day

# Tuesday, May 20th • Arrive at UNF — Field House at 4:30pm

- School will be dismissed at 12.
- No cell phones during ceremony
- Clear bags ONLY!!!!!
- Graduates will be screened upon entry
- (NO cell phones, dress code, cords/stoles)
- Audience admission begins at 4:30pm
- Leave time for parking and the walk over
- Communicate a post-ceremony meeting point with your family members.



## UNF Graduation Policies

#### Security and Bag Policy

- All guests will proceed through a mag-gate security screening (includes clear bag check and wanding) before gaining entrance to the ceremony.
- Guests with bags that do not meet the policy will not be permitted access into the Arena

#### Parking & Arrival

- Commencement ceremonies take place at the UNF Arena, Building 34. Directional signage around campus will guide guests to Lot 18, the event parking lot. Parking is complimentary.
- The doors to the Arena will open to guests up to **an hour and a half** before the ceremony to accommodate guest volume.
- Your school's graduation ticket is required for entry. Concessions and flower sales will be available within the Arena.
- Pro Tip: Please allow time for parking, walking to the Arena, and the security checkpoint

#### Guest with disabilities

- Guests with disabilities should follow signage for disability parking.
- There are special seating areas for guests with mobility issues or in wheelchairs. An usher can direct your party to these areas.
- If your family needs a sign language interpreter, please contact Ms. Mazerolle.

# UNF Graduation Policies

#### Food

• No food or drink will be permitted.

### Seating

- Guest seating is first-come, first-serve.
- No guests are permitted in the students' seating area at any time. Guests will not be seated during the processional; <u>late arrivals</u> <u>must wait until the procession ends</u>.

### • During the Ceremony

- Photographs. Photographs are encouraged and you must remain seated.
- For the safety of all guests, aisles and walkways should remain clear. Guests are prohibited from standing in aisles or walkways.
- Event staff will ask standing guests to take their seats. Non-compliant guests will be asked to leave. Guests and families are not permitted on the main floor or stage where graduates and school parties are seated. Guests should remain seated through the processional (graduates exiting) before uniting with their graduate in the plaza outside.

### General Etiquette.

- Out of respect for your graduating senior and the enjoyment of all families and guests:
  - Please silence cell phones; remain seated for the entire ceremony; hold applause and refrain from loud celebrations until the conclusion of the ceremony, so that all families can hear their graduate's name announced.

## Graduation Day Dress Code

- Dress pants or khakis, dark socks, shoes and a dress shirt with a tie; or a dress (or skirt with a blouse) with flats or wedges.
- Graduates should avoid wearing jeans, shorts, sandals, or sneakers. High heels are not recommended for safety reasons.
- Academic gown should fall midway between the knee and ankle. Remember to wear the TCHS graduate medallion provided in your Clearance Day packet. Caps should be worn flat on the head. Tassels are worn on the right and shifted to the left after all graduates have received their diploma.
- · Caps can be decorated with the college or military branch only.
- The only additional items other than the cap, gown, tassel, and TCHS graduate medallion are the following approved items...

## Approved Graduation Items

### Honor Cords

Graduation Honor Cords are only allowed for approved GPA recognition, honor societies, and academies. Clubs may NOT wear cords



### Cap Decorating

Only 2-D decoration representing a university, college, or military branch is allowed. No quotes or pictures. Caps that violate decorating guidelines will be taken at graduation inspection.
