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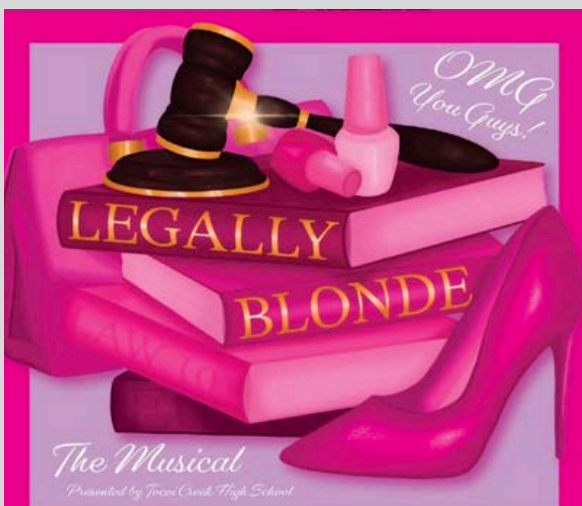

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IMPORTANT AP TESTING INFORMATION!

Advanced Placement Parents/Guardians and Students,

The first AP exam is right around the corner. Your teachers should be preparing the students for what they will need and expectations. Below is a **FAQ** that you should review to be fully prepared.

Q: What time should I (my child) show up for an exam.

A:

For AM Testing: Students should arrive for their exam at 7:30 am

Students with a 7:30am arrival will arrive at Gate A (main entry gate by the car line) to enter campus and walk to testing location.

For PM Testing: Students should arrive for their exam at 11:30am

The exams will start promptly at 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Hence the early arrive.

Late students will NOT be allowed to test.

No shows will have a College Board fee placed on their TCHS debt list.

Q: What should I (my child) bring to the exam?

A: See below:

- **USERNAME & PASSWORD** for AP Classroom to login to BLUEBOOK; this is critical. You will NOT be able to test without it. ONLY your child has access to this info.
- A snack, water, Pens/Pencils. **In a labeled clear zip lock bag.**
- AP ID Labels for Hybrid Exams
- Calculators depending on exam- see policy [here](#)

That is ALL!

- **Bags, books, phones etc. should be left in cars, or lockers, or not brought AT ALL.**
- If there is NO way to leave a phone it MUST be OFF in the clear zip lock bag with student name on it. **If a student's phone goes off or if a student is EVER seen touching their phone at any time once directions are read their test will be invalidated.** If we don't invalidate, we could jeopardize our ability at Toco Creek to offer AP courses and exams. Please talk with your child about this. We will have a ZERO tolerance policy on phones. Additionally, students will be required to turn in all smart watches worn into the exam.

Q: Where is my (my child's) test?

A: Please access the calendar with locations [HERE](#)

Q: Is there a dress code?

A: Students MUST be in dress code, or they will not be allowed to test. Please also remember it can get cold in the GYM/ Labs. We suggest layering.

Q: I (my child) is/am a senior. I want to leave after my exam or not come to school until my exam starts.

A: Please complete the form sent out for parent permission to check out early. Seniors ONLY.

Q: I (my child) is /am an underclassman. Can they leave early/ come late?

A: Underclassmen are expected to report to all classes while not in an AP exam.

Q: When is the late exam?

A: If you need a late exam, you must communicate with AP Coordinator and Assistant Principal, Stacey Johnson if this is needed prior to missing the exam. There is a \$40 fee.

Q: What happens if I (my Child) get sick?

A: Please email stacey.johnson@stjohns.k12.fl.us as soon as possible.

Q: What if I am a "no show" to my AP Exam?

A: You will be given a \$40 unused exam fee on your student debt list

Q: I have questions regarding accommodations for College Board exams (deadline to apply for College Board accommodations was January 20th)

A: Scores will be available to students online at [apcentral.collegeboard.org](https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/apcoreorg) in July.

Q: What is my AP ID?

A: If students need to access their AP ID after the exam administration, they may do so by signing in to My AP (myap.collegeboard.org) using their College Board student sign in. After signing in, students go to My AP Profile and then the Registration tab

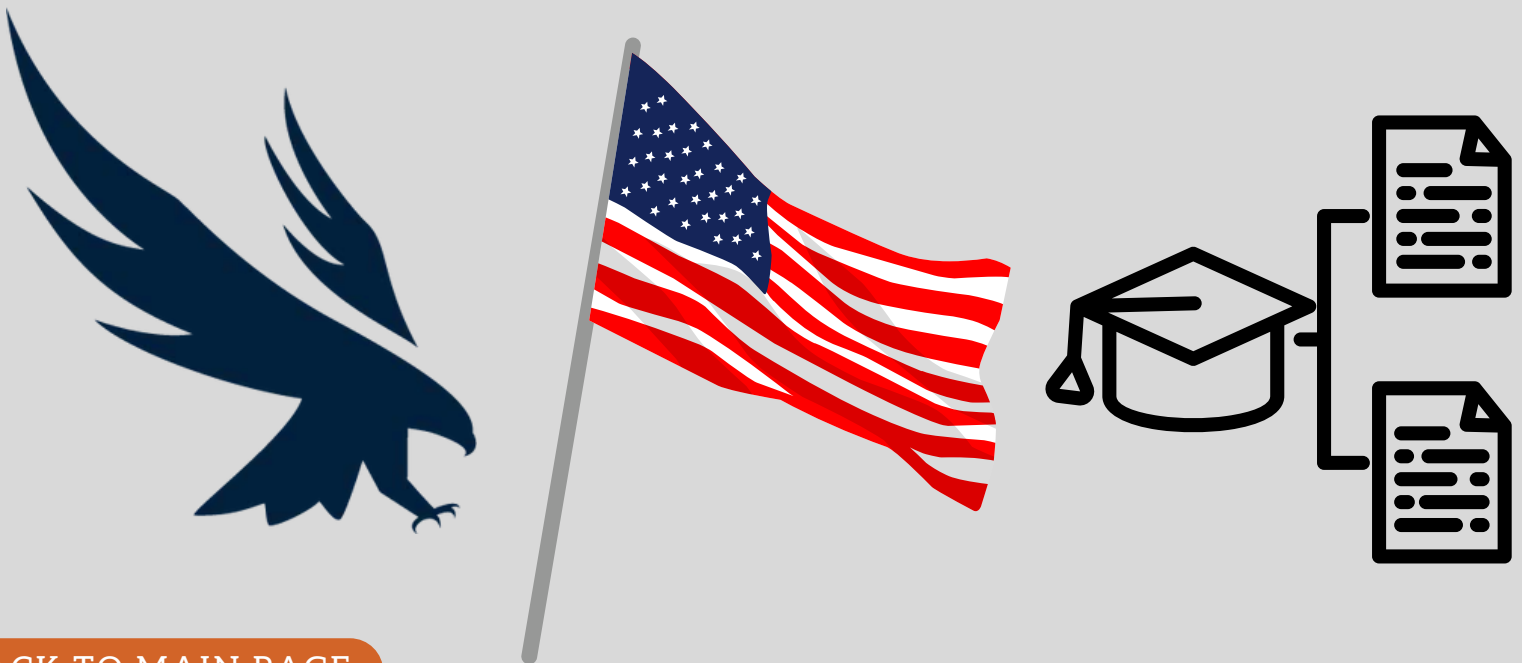

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program:

- Submit a complete and error-free Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application (no later than August 31, 2025);
- Complete the required coursework (by high school graduation);
- Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework;
- Complete the required number of volunteer/paid hours (by established deadline); and
- Achieve the required college entrance exam score for tests taken no later than August 31, 2025. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook for complete program requirements: www.FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org/SAPBFMAIN/SAPBFMAIN.
- Although ACT®, CLT®, and SAT® may offer test dates beyond August 2025, final evaluations for 2025 graduating seniors will only consider test dates for exams taken no later than August 31, 2025, for the Bright Futures Scholarship Programs authorized by rule 6A-20.028, Florida Administrative Code.

Bright Futures Summer Funding:

- Funding is available during the summer term for Bright Futures Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) and Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS). Funding is only available if the postsecondary institution allows an FAS/FMS student to enroll as a degree-seeking student during the summer term. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook, Chapter 2 for more information.

For those of you attending a postsecondary institution for the first time this summer or fall semester, your head must be filled with questions and thoughts about what to expect. College is an exciting place, but it can be complete chaos if you are not prepared. Don't worry, we have your back! Complete this checklist and get a jump start on the right path.

- ☐ Open a savings account and start saving.
- ☐ Research your college. Find out more about different activities and clubs they are known for and student organizations offered on campus.
- ☐ Register for classes. Between orientation or just an appointment with an advisor, make sure you register for classes by the deadline.
- ☐ Handle all financial aid matters before the start of your first

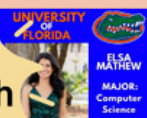

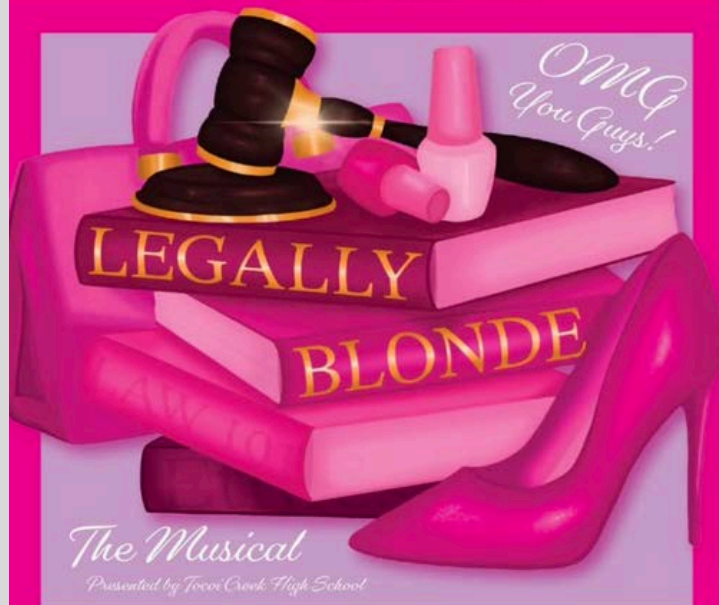

- 6) Type your information (not your child’s information) in the boxes.

- 8) Click “Register”
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child’s information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child’s name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. 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The Bull Pen - This is your weekly news feed that will have everything accessible in a digital format. Past publications can be found on the TCHS website. This is a BIG document that will have ALL that is needed for a successful year.

TCHS Website - Your “one-stop-shop” for everything OFFICAL you need to know about TCHS. Need a calendar of events? Want to talk to your Toro’s counselor? Need to know information about clubs, activities, or events? [The TCHS website is your spot!](#)

HAC - Home Access Center is the digital hub for grades, student information, view bus stop information, where interims and report cards are posted.

Freshman Day - August 1st - This is a special day where your 9th Grade Toro gets to meet their Junior or Senior assigned mentor, tour the school, meet staff, and learn how to be a Toro. This is a “drop and go” activity for Toros only (no parents allowed). If you have a new Toro coming to TCHS

Toro RoundUP - Beginning of the school year event, before school starts, where parents and students can walk their schedule, purchase spirit wear, get parking passes (11th and 12th grade students only who have been selected), get lockers, meet staff, and get oriented for the new year. All family members are invited. Teachers will **not** be assessable during these events.

Meet the Teacher - August 9th from 8am-11am students and families can walk their schedule and go inside each of their classes. This is a self-timed event where families can come and go as needed.

Schoology - Digital platform that students use to interact with each teacher, store documents, message school personnel, and receive updates and important reminders. Students are automatically enrolled and can access from any device that connects to the net.

AUP - Acceptable Use Policy - this document is the “**rule book for using electronic devices/platforms**” for the St. Johns County School District. All staff, students, and visitors must acknowledge/sign their AUP at the beginning of each year prior to utilizing any digital resource at school. A digital link will be provided to each student/family within the first few days of school.

RSV - Returning Student Verification - Process that parents must do each year at the beginning of each school year to verify their residency, school location, and general family contact information.

Digital ID by Leonard’s - All students who utilize a digital smart phone are expected to download the Digital ID by Leonard’s app to receive special messages, purchase a lunch, check out media materials, and to scan into/out of school. The app can be located in the Apple or Google Stores.

The Hub - The TCHS Media Center found on floor 2 of Building 1 where Toros can check out books, digital media, print documents, or log into a computer. The Hub also has a coffee shop where Toros can get the latest offerings of specialty drinks.

GoFan - Digital platform where students can purchase tickets to athletic and social events. NEW this year, students can purchase an ALL ACCESS sports pass for \$75 in GoFan. [Click HERE for more information.](#)

School Pay - Digital pay portal that parents/students can access to purchase dance tickets, pay for Fair Share, or school fees. Parents can set up an account for quick and consistent access, or pay as a guest as needed.

Pay Pams - Digital portal where parents can load, monitor, and/or restrict lunch account activities. Want to set limits or pay automatically when funds become low..PayPams is your portal. Parents are encouraged to set this process up digitally even if they want to have their child pay with cash/check as you will still get the same ability to monitor the account.
