

Phase I: Learner Permit Preparation – \$30.00 A classroom lecture designed to assist a student preparing to obtain a Learner Permit.
The classes are conducted prior to school from 9am-11:309am for a total of 4 consecutive school days. On the last day, students will be administered the Learner Permit Knowledge Exam that is required to obtain a Learner Permit. In addition to the Phase I course, students must also complete a state required 4hour online drug and alcohol course prior to obtaining a Learner Permit. Participation by a minimum of five students is required, or the class will be canceled and a refund issued.



Dual Enrollment:

We will begin taking registration forms for on campus Dual Enrollment (ENC, FIN, SLS) starting on March 24, 2025. Students MUST complete steps 1-5 of the Dual Enrollment Application Process (see steps here: <u>https://www-tchs.stjohns.k12.fl.us/guidance/dual-enrollment-general-information/</u>), meet eligibility requirements, and TURN IN the Consent Form, Test Scores, and Registration form FILLED OUT with the desired course to Ms. Nicole Rickets in the 3rd floor guidance office to secure a seat. We have a limited number of seats in the course, so seats will be given out on a first come, first serve basis.



NAVIGATING YOUR FINANCIAL FUTURE



April - May 2025

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program:

- Submit a complete and error-free Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA), also known as the state application (no later than August 31, 2025);
- Complete the required coursework (by high school graduation);
- Achieve the required grade point average in the required coursework;
- Complete the required number of volunteer/paid hours (by established deadline); and
- Achieve the required college entrance exam score for tests taken no later than August 31, 2025. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook for complete program requirements: <u>www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org/SAPBFMAIN/SAPBFMAIN</u>.
- Although ACT[®], CLT[®], and SAT[®] may offer test dates beyond August 2025, final evaluations for 2025 graduating seniors will only consider test dates for exams taken no later than August 31, 2025, for the Bright Futures Scholarship Programs authorized by rule 6A-20.028, Florida Administrative Code.

Bright Futures Summer Funding:

 Funding is available during the summer term for Bright Futures Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) and Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS). Funding is only available if the postsecondary institution allows an FAS/FMS student to enroll as a degree-seeking student during the summer term. Refer to the Bright Futures Student Handbook, Chapter 2 for more information.

For those of you attending a postsecondary institution for the first time this summer or fall semester, your head must be filled with questions and thoughts about what to expect. College is an exciting place, but it can be complete chaos if you are not prepared. Don't worry, we have your back! Complete this checklist and get a jump start on the right path.

- Open a savings account and start saving.
- Research your college. Find out more about different activities and clubs they are known for and student organizations offered on campus.
- Register for classes. Between orientation or just an appointment with an advisor, make sure you register for classes by the deadline.
- Handle all financial aid matters before the start of your first

class. It's easy to forget about or simply avoid, but this is one way that you can really get messed up.

- Go shopping! Get all of the things you'll need for your classes, your dorm room, or your new wardrobe. Look into your upcoming booklist and research affordable options.
- Research college majors. Whether you're pretty sure what your path is or you have no idea, do some research. Look up course list, graduation rate, job expectancy, income level, etc. Narrow it down to a few that interest you and be ready to talk to an advisor.

SCHOOLOGY PARENT ACCESS

How to Login and Use Schoology Parent Access

Schoology Parent Access allows parents to easily see Schoology information for all of their children in one place.

If you have previously signed up for Schoology Parent Access for your child, you do not need to do so again. If you have not created a Schoology Parent Access Account or need to add a child to your account, please follow these instructions. Please note: If you forget your Schoology Parent Access Account password, you will need to follow the instructions provided on the Schoology.com site to reset or retrieve your password. The St Johns County School District does not have access to parent account passwords.

You will need to find the Schoology Parent Access Code for your Child. This is located in HAC under "Registration" and then "Additional Information"

If you have never used Schoology Parent Access:

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Click on "Register"
- 3) Click on "Parent"
- 4) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code from HAC
- 5) Click "Continue"
- 6) Type your information (not your child's information) in the boxes.
- 7) Check the appropriate boxes at that bottom of your information
- 8) Click "Register"
- 9) You are now logged into Schoology Parent Access.



To see your child's information, go to the right side of the screen and click on the down arrow near your name. Click on your child's name. You will now be able to see all of the information in Schoology related to your child including updates, discussion posts, tests and quizzes, and calendar items.

If you have another child at a St Johns County School District school that is using Schoology, you can easily add them to your parent access account by following these steps. Click on the down arrow near your name on the right of the screen. Scroll down and click "add child." Type in the access code for that child (provided to you by your child's school). Click "Use Code." You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts.

If you already have a Schoology Parent Access account (created for a child at another SJCSD school):

- 1) Go to <u>www.schoology.com</u>
- 2) Login with the information you used to create the account
- 3) Click on the down arrow near your name on the right side of the screen
- 4) Click on "add child"
- 5) Type in the Schoology Parent Access Code that can be found in HAC
- 6) Click "Use Code"

7) You can now easily switch between your children's Schoology accounts by going to the drop down arrow and selecting the child's account you wish to view.

<u>The Bull Pen</u> - This is your weekly news feed that will have everything accessible in a digital format. Past p<mark>u</mark> on the TCHS website. This is a BIG document that will have ALL that is needed for a successful year.

TCHS Website - Your "one-stop-shop" for everything OFFICAL you need to know about TCHS. Need a calendar of events? Want to talk to your Toro's counselor? Need to know information about clubs, activities, or events? <u>The TCHS website is your spot!</u>

HAC - Home Access Center is the digital hub for grades, student information, view bus stop information, where interims and report cards are posted.

Freshman Day - August 1st - This is a special day where your 9th Grade Toro gets to meet their Junior or Senior assigned mentor, tour the school, meet staff, and learn how to be a Toro. This is a "drop and go" activity for Toros only (no parents allowed). If you have a new Toro coming to TCHS

Toro RoundUP - Beginning of the school year event, before school starts, where parents and students can walk their schedule, purchase spirit wear, get parking passes (11th and 12th grade students only who have been selected), get lockers, meet staff, and get oriented for the new year. All family members are invited. Teachers will **not** be assessable during these events.

<u>Meet the Teacher</u> - August 9th from 8am-11am students and families can walk their schedule and go inside each of their classes. This is a self-timed event where families can come and go as needed.

<u>Schoology</u> - Digital platform that students use to interact with each teacher, store documents, message school personnel, and receive updates and important reminders. Students are automatically enrolled and can access from any device that connects to the net.

AUP - Acceptable Use Policy - this document is the "rule book for using electronic devices/platforms" for the St. Johns County School District. All staff, students, and visitors must acknowledge/sign their AUP at the beginning of each year prior to utilizing any digital resource at school. A digital link will be provided to each student/family within the first few days of school.

RSV - Returning Student Verification - Process that parents must do each year at the beginning of each school year to verify their residency, school location, and general family contact information.

Digital ID by Leonard's - All students who utilize a digital smart phone are expected to download the Digital ID by Leonard's app to receive special messages, purchase a lunch, check out media materials, and to scan into/out of school. The app can be located in the Apple or Google Stores.

The Hub - The TCHS Media Center found on floor 2 of Building 1 where Toros can check out books, digital media, print documents, or log into a computer. The Hub also has a coffee shop where Toros can get the latest offerings of specialty drinks.

GoFan - Digital platform where students can purchase tickets to athletic and social events. NEW this year, students can purchase an ALL ACCESS sports pass for \$75 in GoFan. <u>Click HERE for more information.</u>

<u>School Pay</u> - Digital pay portal that parents/students can access to purchase dance tickets, pay for Fair Share, or school fees. Parents can set up an account for quick and consistent access, or pay as a guest as needed.

Pay Pams - Digital portal where parents can load, monitor, and/or restrict lunch account activities. Want to set limits or pay automatically when funds become low..PayPams is your portal. Parents are encouraged to set this process up digitally even if they want to have their child pay with cash/check as you will still get the same ability to monitor the account. <u>Click HERE for information on PayPAMS or MealView access</u>.
